## This funding will be used to


- Improve Literacy and Numeracy levels across the school with a heavy focus on the Early Years.
- Increase the number of students reaching Upper 2 bands in Reading and Numeracy in Years 3 and 5.
- Ensure every student enrolled in Year 3 and Year 5 attains National Minimum Standard in Reading and Numeracy, or has an Individual Learning Plan.
- Ensure Individual Support Programs are developed and supported where required.

## Our initiatives include

- Purchasing 1.0 Full Time Equivalent (FTE) teacher time to allow for smaller class sizes, notably in the lower years
- Purchasing 0.2 FTE for Support Programs in Upper 2 Bands, and Individual Support Programs.
- Purchasing teacher aide time to support reading programs across the school, thus allowing continuation of 'Fly-in' teams for reading groups.
- Purchase curriculum resources to support programs as required.
